There is a new presence on campus. The goBEYOND Project Initiative. goBEYOND is a grassroots project developed by the BC Campus Climate Network. As a "youth-led" project, goBEYOND works to educate . . . inspire, engage and support students in taking climate action at British Columbia's colleges and universities. It is their belief that campuses can goBEYOND climate-neutral by taking responsibility for social and ecological impacts while taking the opportunity to create climate change solutions for our communities.

goBEYOND's presence here at RRU is funded by CRD, BC Hydro, and the Victoria Foundation. It is also supported by the Office of Sustainability at RRU. This year's goBEYOND Campus Organizer is Susan Kerr. She is located in Building #14 alongside Nancy Wilkin, Director of Sustainability.
